

## **Copying the MRMS Menu from Live AWIPS to WES-2 Bridge Workstation WES-2 Bridge Build 14.3.1**

**April 18, 2016**

These instructions present the steps necessary to install a working MRMS menu on WES-2 Bridge. This assumes the WES-2 Bridge contains the 14.3.1 build of AWIPS. This work-around is no longer needed in subsequent builds. The strategy copies the one necessary “base” menu file from the CAVE installation on an LX workstation and uses it as a site-level override on WES-2 Bridge. Perform these steps only after having copied your operational localization from the 7dayRollover to the WES-2 Bridge workstation.

In Build 14.3.1, there is an MRMS menu that is delivered as part of CAVE. However, it references products identified as “MRMS” rather than “MRMS\_0500” and “MRMS\_1000”, which is how MRMS appears in later builds.

### **Step 1: Create the target directory to contain the site override menu file.**

On the WES-2 Bridge workstation, perform this following command:

```
mkdir /awips2/edex/data/utility/cave_static/site/XXX/menus/mrms
```

where “XXX” is your site identifier.

If this directory already exists, then you would have performed copying the MRMS menu in the previous 14.2.4 build. In that case, delete the contents of this folder before continuing.

### **Step 2: Copy the one necessary MRMS menu file to WES-2 Bridge.**

From the command line of a terminal on an LX workstation at your site, perform the following copy command.

```
scp -r /awips2/cave/etc/menus/mrms/mrmsProducts.xml  
user@wes2:/awips2/edex/data/utility/cave_static/site/XXX/menus/mrms
```

where “user” is your username on the WES-2 Bridge user account and “XXX” is your site identifier.
